## What Is PRE-AP?

At Lloydminster Comprehensive High School, students may take Pre-Advanced Placement (AP) courses. An Advanced Placement course is equivalent to a first-year university course, and successful students may receive academic credit or advanced standing at participating universities in Canada, the United States and overseas. At LCHS, students in Grade 10 may take a more rigorous program that helps prepare them for entering other Pre-AP ELA courses and the AP English Literature and Composition course in Grade 12.
