Dr. Malcolm Gray Memorial Scholarship

Lloydminster Animal Hospital in conjunction with the family of Dr. Malcolm Gray

Purpose:

This scholarship has been set up as a tribute to the late Dr. Malcolm Gray to recognize his contribution to the field of Veterinary Medicine and the Lloydminster region. The intent is to award a scholarship of \$1000.00 annually to a Grade 12 graduate entering a recognized post-secondary institution in a field of studies related to veterinary medicine.

Dr. Malcolm David Gray was born in Elk Point, Alberta in 1946 and grew up on the family farm near Dewberry. After completing high school he attended the Western College of Veterinary Medicine in Saskatoon and graduated with a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree in 1972. Dr. Gray worked in private practices in Vancouver and Lloydminster during the 1970s and earned certification in veterinary epidemiology from the Ontario Veterinary College. After working with the Federal Government Health of Animals Department in various Western Canadian centers, Dr. Gray returned to private practice in 1980 and together with Dr. Sue Ashburner founded the Lloydminster Animal Hospital. He practiced in Lloydminster until 1990. After leaving private practice, Dr. Gray served as Registrar of the Alberta Veterinary Medical Association. He then joined the Food Production and Inspection Branch of Agriculture Canada, working on animal disease surveillance and testing throughout Canada and in the United Kingdom.

Dr. Gray was very active in his profession and the community, serving as President of the Alberta Veterinary Medical Association, Lloydminster Exhibition Association, and the Lloydminster Progressive Conservative Association. He passed away in August 2002 at the age of 56 years.

Amount: \$1000.00

Eligibility:

The applicant must be a Grade 12 graduate of an accredited high school within the practice area of Lloydminster Animal Hospital.

At the time of awarding the scholarship, the applicant must be enrolled full time in a post-secondary institution such as a university or college.

The applicant must be enrolled in a course of studies in a field related to veterinary medicine with priority given to Pre-Veterinary Medicine and Animal Health Technology.

Requirements:

Applications shall include:

- a complete resume outlining extra curricular activities and community involvement
- a handwritten one-page submission outlining their intentions for future endeavours
- an abstract of Grade 12 marks

Administration:

A Scholarship Selection Committee of five people selected by Lloydminster Animal Hospital will determine the successful applicant.

The determination will be made on the basis of the written submission, academic standing, extra-curricular activities and community involvement.

Funding:

Lloydminster Animal Hospital will present a \$1000.00 cheque to the student selected by the Scholarship Selection Committee
