Requirements:

Candidate must be completing grade 11 or graduating from grade 12 at the Lloydminster Comprehensive High School. Alternatively, candidate may apply in the year immediately following highschool graduation (ie. by July 15 of the calendar year following graduation).

The candidate must be planning to attend some form of post-secondary education.

Scholarship Description and Goal:

This \$250 scholarship is awarded to a student who has worked toward making an impact on an international scale and/or encourages others to consider global issues. The student must demonstrate leadership, as well as interest in cross-cultural issues. Examples of demonstrated interest may include fundraising for international causes, involvement in a cultural group to which the candidate is not familiar with, learning a new language, going on a rotary exchange, etc.

Please note: Travel and first-hand experiences outside of the country are not a requirement in order to be considered for this scholarship; however, these experiences may be applicable.

This scholarship is intended to encourage critical thinking of, and leadership in, global issues, as well as consideration of cross-cultural relationships.
