#### LLOYDMINSTER TEACHERS' ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

#### Purpose

The Lloydminster Teachers' Association Scholarship is intended to assist students from The Lloydminster Comprehensive High School and Holy Rosary High School who will be pursuing a professional career in Education.

#### Amount of Award

Two (2) \$1500 scholarships are offered. The two scholarships will be awarded to the two best candidates, regardless of the school division.

## Eligibility

Applicants must be members of the current graduating class in their respective schools and must declare intent to pursue a professional teaching degree.

## **Application Package**

The application package must include the following:

- 1. A cover letter stating their intent to apply for the scholarship.
- 2. A final transcript of grades.
- 3. A copy of their letter of acceptance into an Education program or a program leading to an Education degree.
- 4. A resume outlining the following:
  - A record of community service
  - A record of school involvement (extra-curricular activity, teams, or other school engagement).
  - An employment record may be included, but is not required.
- 5. Two (2) letters of reference in support of stated community service and school involvement.
- 6. A brief statement as to why the applicant wishes to enter the teaching profession.

## **Selection Procedure**

1. The LTA shall appoint a selection committee of three members that will adjudicate the applications.

- 2. Each candidate will be assigned a point tally to a maximum of 100 points based upon the following criteria:
  - a. Scholastic Achievement: each applicant will be assigned a maximum of 50 points based on the average of five (5) 30 level courses: ELA A30, ELA B30, Math 30, Science 30, and one other 30 level course. French Immersion students may use Francais Immersion 30 in place of one of the ELA courses if they choose.
  - b. Extra-curricular School Involvement: each applicant will be assigned a maximum of 25 points based upon information contained in the resume.
  - c. Voluntary Community Service: each applicant will be assigned a maximum of 25 points based upon information contained in the resume.
