# Description of the Scholarship:

One scholarship in the amount of \$1000 shall be awarded annually to recognize a student entering the accounting field who best represents the values of school and community involvement, cooperation, and participation. The scholarship shall be awarded for the years of 2011 to 2021. For subsequent years, the scholarship will continue in the same amount however the duration beyond 2021 shall be contingent upon further donations by the donor.

### **Purpose of Scholarships:**

- To encourage students to select the accounting field as their profession
- To provide financial assistance

### **Eligibility:**

The student must be a graduating student of LCHS, from the current school year, who will be enrolling in a B. Comm. Program.

#### **Selection Criteria:**

- An individual who is planning on working towards receiving a professional accounting designation and working in public practice and who has also shown active participation in school and community events
- Financial need

# Administration:

- 1. The Lloydminster Comprehensive High School Scholarship committee will administer the awarding of the scholarship
- If potential recipients are judged to be equally deserving of the scholarship, the scholarship shall be awarded to the applicant who has received less scholarship money and demonstrates greater financial need
- 3. In the event a suitable recipient has not been identified, the scholarship(s) shall be carried forward to the following year
- 4. All nominations shall be dealt with in a confidential manner
- 5. The Scholarship donor (when available) will present the scholarship at the annual Scholarship day hosted by Lloydminster Comprehensive High School

### Application procedure:

On or before May 31<sup>st</sup>, the LCHS Scholarship committee will accept all applications for consideration. All applications will contain the following information:

- A letter of application including letters of reference
- Biographical information including evidence of the importance of school and community involvement in their personal lives.
- Educational plans
- Nomination form
