

Stewart Art Scholarship

Name of Scholarship: Stewart Art Scholarship

Donors: LCHS Magazine Campaign

Rationale: Proceeds for this scholarship came from fundraising that was done on behalf of Mr. Duff Stewart upon his retirement and through the magazine fundraising campaign. Mr. Stewart had been involved in the magazine program at LCHS for many years supporting literacy and the arts. Mr. Stewart was one of the staff liaisons for the project and as such had become closely connected to this major fundraiser. The campaign organizers have requested an opportunity to generate the scholarship in Mr. Stewart's honor.

Description of the Scholarship: An annual scholarship in the amount of \$250.00 will be awarded to a graduating student at LCHS. The Scholarship will be awarded for the years of 2016 to 2020. Scholarships will continue in the same amount beyond 2021, contingent upon further donations by contributing donors.

Purpose of Scholarships:

- a) To recognize students who have demonstrated a strong desire to pursue a career in the arts regardless of academic standing.
- b) To recognize students who have demonstrated a strong work ethic.
- c) To encourage students to continue their education beyond a high school diploma.

Eligibility: Applicants must:

- a) Be graduating from grade 12 at LCHS.
- b) Preference may be given to students continuing with a post-secondary education related to the arts.

Administration:

- a) The funds available for the scholarships in any given year will be managed by Lloydminster Public School Division.
- b) Scholarship selections will be brokered by the Lloydminster Public School Division Scholarship Selection committee.
- c) All nominations will be dealt with in a confidential manner.

Application procedure: Applicants must:

- a) Submit a paragraph (not more than 200 words) outlining how creating art has impacted their life.
- b) Submit two (2) digital photos of two visual art pieces they have created, including a brief description of each piece.

Completed application packages must be submitted to the Lloydminster Public School Division Scholarship Selection Committee at the address below by not later than May 31st.
