### 1. GRAD FEES:

- Fees will be collected through SchoolCash. Please log in to pay. The front office will also take cash, credit, or debit.
- ALL OUTSTANDING SCHOOL FEES MUST BE PAID prior to participating in the cap and gown ceremony. Outstanding textbooks must also be returned.
- Grad fees are \$90 and cover the following:

# 2. GRAD PACKAGES / CAP & GOWN

- Grad packages contain a composite picture of our graduates, academic award certificates, notices of recognition from Government officials, and a few other items.
- Must be picked up between 10-12 or 1-2 on Wednesday, June 25th in the library. If you are not participating in the Grad activities, packages will be available in the LCHS office after this time.
- All outstanding LCHS School Fees/Fines must be cleared up prior to you receiving your Grad Package and Cap and Gown.

### Grad Gowns

- The Grad Gown is somewhat transparent. A dress or dress pants and dress shoes would look best with the gown. You may wish to pin the V-stole in place as they do tend to move around.
  - CAUTION: Do NOT IRON the gown steam only!

## 3. CAP AND GOWN CEREMONY - Thursday, June 26th at 10:30am

- This Ceremony is open to the public, however, seating is limited and on a first-come first-served basis. Be sure to arrive early to ensure that you get a seat.
- Guests enter via the main entrance. Graduates will have a separate entrance between the WLS building and the Culligan Water building.
- The Cap & Gown Ceremony will be live-streamed; the link will be provided via email at a date closer to grad.
- In order to participate in the Cap & Gown Ceremony students must meet graduation requirements as set out by the Saskatchewan Ministry of Education. Students who do not acquire the 24 credits necessary will **not** be allowed to participate in the Cap and Gown Ceremony.

### LINE UP TO GO INTO THE CULLIGAN WATER BUILDING

 At the Cap and Gown Ceremony, Graduates meet in the Prairie Room to be lined up by 9:45 <u>sharp</u> to go into the CULLIGAN WATER BUILDING by 10:15. <u>The</u> <u>Ceremony begins at 10:30.</u>  Several teachers will be there to help you line up; however, please proceed to the designated area until you find the list with your name on it. <u>Stay there</u> until one of the teachers puts you into the final lineup to go into the CULLIGAN WATER BUILDING.

### INTRODUCTION OF GRADS

- 1. The ceremony will begin with a march of the graduates around the CULLIGAN WATER BUILDING.
- 2. You will return to the Prairie room to your alphabetized groupings. Teachers will assist you. <u>Please be quiet as you proceed out of the Prairie room.</u>
- 3. As you walk towards the center of the stage, Mrs. Block, Mrs. Spence, and Mr. Smith will read your name and announce any awards you have achieved. Mr. Marciniw will give you your portfolio and shake your hand. At this point, change your tassel from the right of your cap to the left side. This symbolic gesture recognizes your shift from student to graduate. Don't rush, people want to see you! Smile for the camera!
- 4. Step down from the stage, and proceed to your seat on the riser. Grads alternate from one side to the other. Walk all the way to the top of the risers and fill up the seats from left to right. Sit quietly until the graduating class is asked to stand and be congratulated. Do not throw your cap at this point; wait until the end of the entire ceremony.

### Remember:

- 1. Be quiet in the hallway, at the back of the risers, and in your seats.
- 2. Walk slowly and smile. This is your moment in the limelight. Enjoy it.
- As you are not allowed to leave the risers once the ceremony has started, be sure to use washroom facilities before entering the CULLIGAN WATER BUILDING.
- 4. You are in full view of the entire audience, please act accordingly and honour your fellow graduates as they cross the stage.
- 5. School rules apply -students under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be removed from the line-up and asked to leave.
- 6. Don't be late! All times are exact.
