Marjorie Ranger, a long-time member of the Marshall Rebekah Lodge, was also an enthusiastic and dedicated teacher. It was her wish to leave an annual scholarship to financially assist grade twelve students who are pursuing post-secondary education.

The Marjorie Ranger Scholarship of \$1000.00 will be awarded to each of two students, one male and one female, from each of the following high schools: Lloydminster Comprehensive High School, Holy Rosary High School, and Lashburn High School.

The following criteria will apply:

- I. Must be a current grade twelve student at one of the previously mentioned high schools.
- II. Must be enrolled in a degree, diploma, or certificate program at a University or Community College in the province of Saskatchewan or Alberta
- III. Qualifying factors include financial need, reasonable grades, community involvement, and good potential for course completion

Please include the following documents:

- Application form
- Final grade twelve transcript
- Proof of enrollment at post-secondary institution
- Two letters of reference – one from a school official and one from a community leader or member
- Essay

Students must submit a short essay of no less than 500 words describing interests and activities throughout high school, detailing the importance of education, financial need, community involvement, academic success, and extracurricular endeavors.

The Scholarship Committee will be particularly interested in topics relating to key issues of education, community spirit, and financial need.

All documents must be submitted to the Guidance Advisor by May 31st of each year.
