

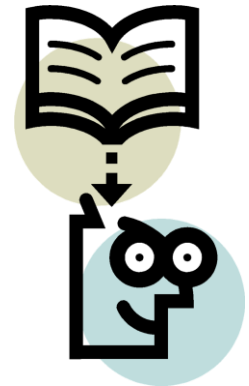

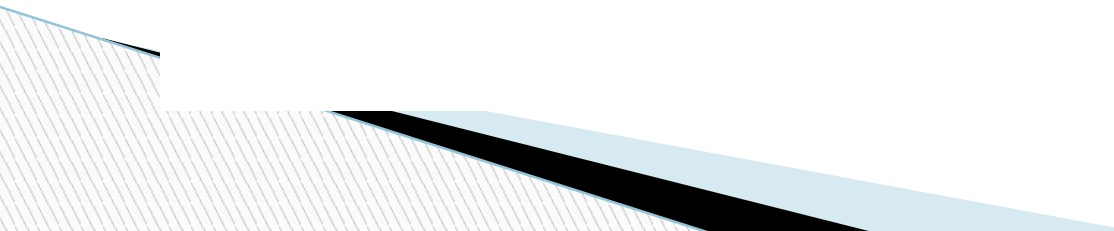

Admission

1. Admission begins in October and conditional acceptance may be granted based on your grade 11 marks.

4. Some institutions are first apply/first qualify/first accepted so apply in October
5. Look for scholarships at the University or College.

***Make sure to keep your password and username in your phone or somewhere safe.

Important Dates

1. October– early acceptance starts/send in **official** transcript
2. December –scholarships are due for Universities/Colleges.
3. January– send in **official** transcripts from Regina.
4. When your child turns 18 the institutions will not speak to parents unless a consent form is on file. Please make sure to do this to assist your child.
5. February–March– check your portals to make sure you have all they require. Deadline to apply is usually March 1st.
6. March–April– some institutions ask for midterm sem 2 marks. If so see Mrs. Spence to get an unofficial transcript for you to upload
7. June– send in **official** final transcript

Official Saskatchewan Transcript must now be ordered online.

All Post Secondary Institutions will require a final official high school transcript before final acceptance will be given. As well, you need to send an official transcript to Alberta Scholarships for the Alexander Rutherford.

Scholarships and Bursaries

- Now is the time to begin initial planning for scholarships and bursaries. This includes:
 1. Volunteering and extracurricular involvement– ongoing or single time – community and school --- up to 15 points are awarded in each of these categories for a total of 30 out of a possible 55 points.
 2. Building a scholarship resume – different than a work resume.
 3. Thinking of references/letters of reference – ask early!!!



Listen for announcements or Remind 101 texts about upcoming scholarship workshops to be held every second Friday at lunch. Volunteer opportunities will also be shared as we are made aware of them.

LCHS website is a good place to start your Scholarship research. These scholarship applications are not due until end of May. Others may be due prior to this date so please do your research early.

Check with your parent's work or community affiliations as they may have scholarships available.

We will be having a scholarship evening early second semester to give more details.



Province of Alberta– Alexander Rutherford High School Achievement Scholarship

1. Awarded to as many Alberta high school students who qualify. Money is awarded at the completion of grade 12, but is based on academic average in grade 10, 11 and 12
1. Students are eligible for money in the range of \$300 up to a maximum of \$2500
2. More on this at scholarship night.
